FY2012 Expenditures – sponsored agreements

\$1.2B - *seven schools, one National Laboratory and 18 interdisciplinary labs, institutes and centers*

Federal funding 2012 \$ 1.03 billion

- NIH \$417 million
- DOE SLAC \$373
- NSF \$ 86
- DOD \$ 85
- DOE \$ 23
- NASA \$ 21
- Other \$ 25

Non-federal funding \$197 million
