# From NSF Rules of the Road

*This report builds on extensive feedback from community stakeholders and establishes key principles for NSF's research security analytics activities:*

- 1. Program staff are **not permitted to use research security concerns as a determining factor** in the merit review process.*
- 2. All research security analytics activities at NSF will be conducted solely by the Office of the Chief of Research Security Strategy and Policy, or OCRSSP. That office will reach out to the institution RSO with questions.*

*[NOTE: No program officer queries to PI's about inconsistencies.]*

- 3. Program staff are not permitted to conduct intentional information querying activities related to research security. Concerns encountered during routine merit review activities (see "routine assessment" in definitions) are to be reported to OCRSSP.*

- Framework for analyzing common academic activities (e.g., sabbaticals, collaborations) under research security requirements
- Tools/strategies to support research programs' response to new technology being used in research (e.g., AI)—particularly in human subject development of algorithms using medical data
- Roadblocks to research – identifying areas in federal human subjects, animal, and research integrity regulations that make it difficult for emerging institutions to “get in the game” along with potential solutions
